



30th October – UK Business Secretary announces Symetrica SmartScan

The UK Business Secretary Vince Cable announces funding for Symetrica's SmartScan (£954,741) as part of a wider series of investments addressing innovation challenges across UK industry. SmartScan delivers new 'detector' technologies allowing more affordable and sustainable analysis of nuclear waste materials, avoiding the use of He-3 produced predominantly as a by-product of US nuclear warhead maintenance. The project brings together Symetrica, an SME active in the Homeland Security Market, with Canberra UK, a leader in the Civil Nuclear Industry.

This grant from Innovate UK, the new name for the Technology Strategy Board, delivers further advances in both He-3 free neutron detector technology and de-convolution enhanced gamma ray spectroscopy on a range of spectrometers for the Civil Nuclear Market.
